A few years ago, we had a beautiful AQHA appendix mare booked at stud to our stallion Big Mac Tivio. “Molly” was 19 years old and had not had a foal since she was 8 or 9. Her owners adored both her and her superb bloodlines and wanted a foal badly. Although she looked to be in excellent health and condition, her heats were still virtually non-existent after 3 months of boarding (she inhaled our **2:1!**), great sun, and terrific pheromones all over the place. The vet said it was hopeless, she was just too old and her ovaries felt like walnuts.
