I started my 3 horses on the **DYNAMITE**® program in February, 2003 and have seen fantastic results.

Specifically I have a 15 year old appendix quarter horse gelding "Secret." He was my first horse, and I have owned him for 3½ years. For almost the entire time I've owned him he's had lameness, conformation issues from a previous owner that had him jumping for 5 years. I think honestly she sold him to me between injuries, and myself as a novice-rookie-first-time-horse-owner-to-be never suspected.

Secret has had a contusion to his knee, significant soft tissue swelling with possible ligamentous strain requiring extensive stall rest, a suspensory shoulder strain prior to me owning him, possible arthritis in his hocks, low heels in the front feet requiring corrective shoes with wedge pads, and 2 foot abscesses in the past. This past winter he had a noticeable limp in the right front while just walking in the paddock. I had a vet/chiropractor adjust him and couldn't find the source. A month later I had another vet out to x-ray his right front knee and fetlock (same side as his previous contusion several years prior). The x-rays were all normal.

I had been feeding him a grass/ alfalfa mix, beet pulp, and 4-way. I gave vaccines twice a year, usually a 4-way the same day he had his teeth floated annually, and worming several times a year with conventional products. His attitude was usually crabby, and lazy. In February I started him on straight grass hay (free choice), **1:1**, **2:1**, **Izmine**, **NTM Salt**, **DYNAMITE**® **Regular** (1 scoop) with **Free and Easy**, **DynaPro**, daily **Excel** and 1 cup of **PGR**. After 2 weeks I noticed him running around the pasture completely sound! I since have been taking him on several hours of light trail riding and he hasn't had a lame day yet. His attitude has completely changed, he's a happy horse, and wants to go for rides. He and my other gelding wait at the fence whinnying to go.

I can't thank you enough for your products. In the entire time I've owned Secret I have never seen him look and act this sound and happy. I have since started the human products and have been very pleased.
